

2008 Awards Criteria

The LMC invites you to nominate candidates for our 2008 Awards. Below are criteria and nomination forms for the two awards as well as lists of previous recipients:

Award Criteria

Leadership in Labor-Management Cooperation

This award recognizes outstanding leadership in labor-management cooperation. Recipients can be an individual, a pair or team of individuals, an organization or partnering organizations. The recipient(s) is selected by the LMC Executive Committee (excluding any committee member who is nominated or directly affiliated with a nominee). Nominations must be received no later than Feb. 15, 2008. Recipients will be announced at the April 17, 2008 Awards Dinner.

The award recognizes a labor-management relationship that has brought benefits for the employees, the company and the community, and has demonstrated positive and innovative/creative means to do so. This award will be presented to a team of organizations and individuals who:

- (1) have demonstrated economic benefits and improved products/services from their relationship;
- (2) demonstrate a clear vision that is communicated to employees at all levels;
- (3) involve management and union leadership together in developing a vision;
- (4) involve employees at all levels, both union and management, in executing the positive vision;
- (5) have demonstrated good faith collective bargaining by union and management both in negotiations and contract implementation;
- (6) have demonstrated a strong link between customer satisfaction and the role of labor and management; and
- (7) have demonstrated a commitment to a safe workplace.

To be eligible, at least one organization in an entry team must be a member of the Labor Management Council. Nominations may be submitted either by one of the team members or another person(s) familiar with their situation.
